

B	Principles Underlying Nursing Management				
1	The head of the room makes the organizational structure of the room and socializes it to nurses				
2	The head of the room, formulates well the method/assignment system for nurses in the inpatient room				
3	The head of the room, makes clear details of the duties of the person in charge of the team and members of the nursing team				
4	The head of the room, never makes a span of control: in charge of the team leader, the team leader supervises the person in charge of the team and the person in charge of the team supervises the implementing nurse				
5	The head of the room, organizes and properly controls the nursing staff such as making service rotations, nurse work schedules				
6	The head of the room, never sets standards and goals for nursing care in the inpatient room				
7	Head of room, always delegates nursing duties to the team leader when not in place				
8	The head of the room gives authority to administrative staff to properly manage patient administration				
9	The head of the room, never facilitates collaboration with other staff in the inpatient room				
10	The head of the room always coordinates well the services and nursing care in the inpatient room
